- 1. The aim of the Introduction to Medical Biology course is to revise students' knowledge in Biology and to introduce new subject areas, which will contribute to the medical studies that the newcomers undertake.
- 2. The course is mandatory for all the students accepted to the 1st year of the 6-year MD Program and the 5-year DDS Program.
- 3. The Course is considered as passed/failed.
- 4. During the course the student is allowed to miss <u>2 classes without a medical/formal excuse</u>. Absence in other class will be accepted <u>only</u> with a medical certificate of temporary disability obtained from a physician or with an excuse approved by the Dean's office. Such an excuse should be presented to the course coordinator within 7 working days after the first day of absence. After this time absences will not be excused. Unexcused absences preclude the student from taking the final test.
- 5. The course consists of 20 classes (20'2h = 40h) including the final written test, which will be given during the last class. The test will contain at least 30 questions. It will cover problems discussed during the course.
- 6. The final test will take place at the Computer Examination Center, 2 Parkowa Street on 28st of September 2018. The threshold for receiving credit for completing the course is 60%. Unexcused absence during the final test is equal to a fail in the test.
- 7. The course is scored on the basis of the results of the final test after completing regular classes.
- 8. The student may retake the test only twice at dates appointed by jointly by the teacher and the student.

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
